## View from the Top Women's Business Network

Events Room, View from the Top Gallery,  
4<sup>th</sup> floor Waterstone's, Bridlesmith Gate, Nottingham, NG1 2GR

The Network meets the second Wednesday of every month (except August). Its purpose is to bring together women running businesses, to support each other, sell to each other, learn something and explore ways of working collaboratively. The meeting includes a great lunch and *roughly* runs to the following timetable:

Lovely buffet lunch & networking - 12 – 12.50pm

Presentation – 12.50 – 1.45pm

1.45 – 2pm Notices

The venue includes a free exchange table where you can leave details of your business for other participants to pick up, and you can check out people to make contact with.

Marketplace tables – if you'd like more room than the communal exchange table, you can hire one of a limited number of marketplace tables (no more than 6 per meeting) for selling/demonstrations/information. Tables are allocated on a first-come basis with priority given to those that have not previously had a table and to Network Members. September's meeting has a selection of Marketplace Tables with a green theme.

If you would like to be the presenter at a future meeting please include a brief note of your idea with your booking form. We look for presenters who can share something useful with participants – it's not a pitch slot for your business - though it is an opportunity to show what you know or you can do!

### Becoming a Women's Network Member

From April 2008 we are asking participants to consider paying £5/month membership fee to help to facilitate, sustain and develop the Network. Network Members receive a number of immediate benefits which will increase with the growing membership. The starting benefits are:

- § Names of members who advance book to attend the Network meeting will appear in a special 'Members Attending' section of the promotional emails, with a link to their website. At least one mailing goes out per month to over 500 local businesswomen and it is promoted on other sites.
- § Reduced rates for hire of marketplace tables at Network meetings (£25 r/t £40)
- § Hire of VIEw from the Top gallery or meeting room at not-for-profit rates.  
(eg. Main Gallery @ £500 r/t £600/wk. Meeting room delegate rates @ £25/head r/t £27.50)
- § Entitlement to use the VIEw from the Top clubroom available shortly.

**All monies raised through membership are used to support, sustain and develop the Women's Business Network.**

Membership fees of £5/month will be taken by standing order on the first of every month.
